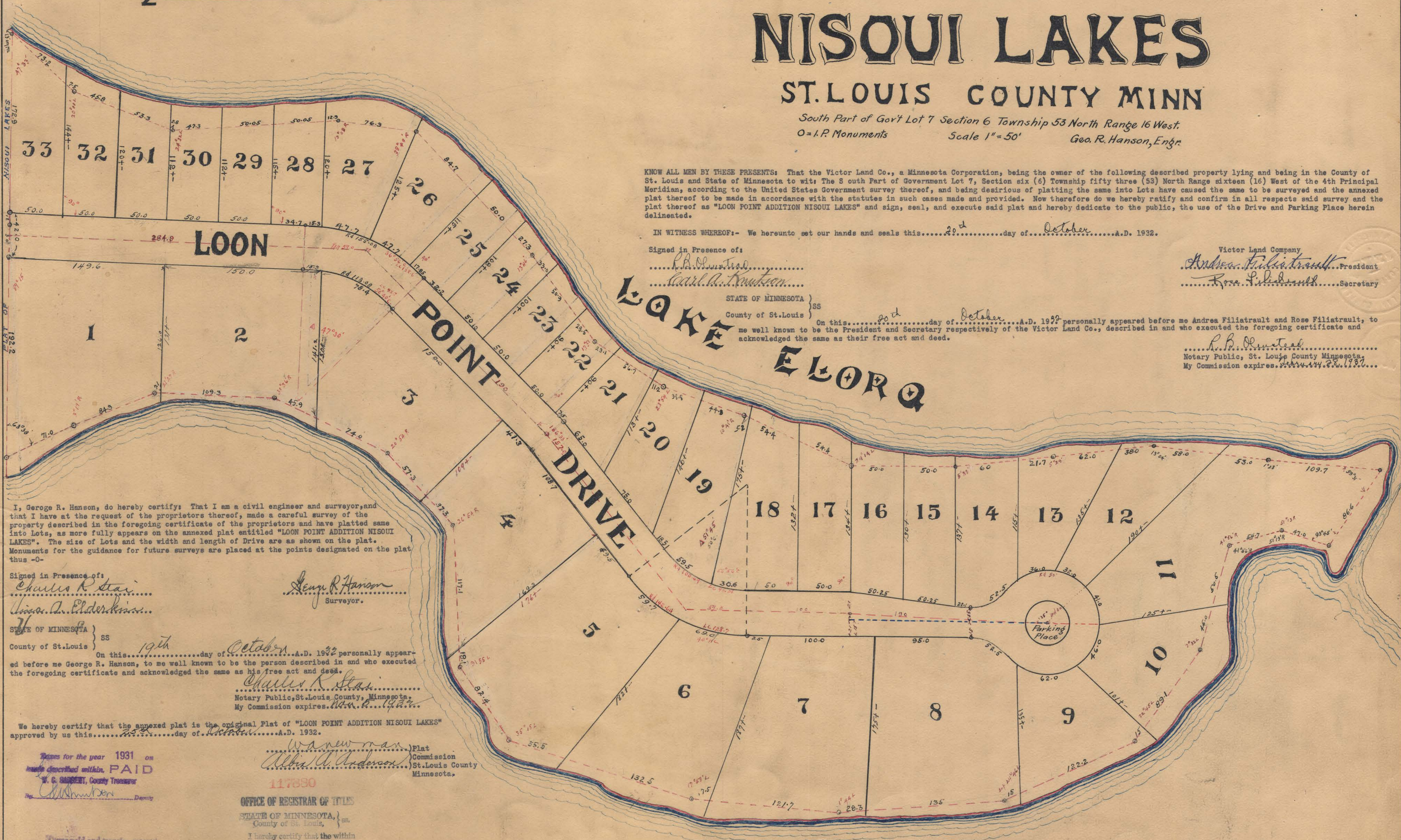


PLAT OF LOON POINT ADDITION NISOU I LAKES
