

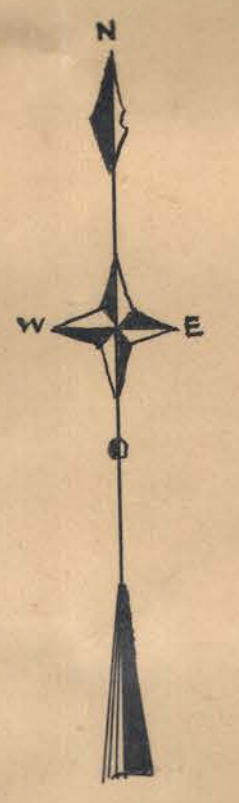

### GOV LOT 6.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:- That Frank P. Winkle and Maud Penter Winkle his wife, being the owners of the following described property lying and being in the County of St. Louis and State of Minnesota to wit: That part of Government Lot Six (6) lying west of County Highway #49, Section Five (5) Township Fifty-Three (53) North Range Sixteen (16) West of the 4th Principal Meridian, according to the United States Government survey thereof, and being desirous of platting the same into Lots, have caused the same to be surveyed and the annexed plat thereof to be made in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided. Due to correction of Government Lot 6, Section 5, shown hereon, Lot 1 of this plat is widened in a southerly direction.
