DO'S AND DON'T'S

1. Do use soap or any of the biodegradable detergents for dishes and clothing. Hard detergents cause the foaming on the beaches and shoreline.
2. Do not use pesticides or weed-killers. They will wash into the lakes, killing fish and necessary plant life.
3. Do not dump "leftover" fishing minnows into the lakes. Most of these are "rough" fish, carp, etc. This is a State Law.
4. Do not allow sewage to drain or be piped into the lakes. This is also a State Law.
5. Do observe boating and water-skiing regulations. Keep a good distance from shore, docks, rafts, swimming areas and other boats on the lake. Watch your speed - and no drinking while driving.
6. Do not throw any "trash" into the lakes. There is a community dump nearby - use it. Particularly, do not drown your beer cans or set logs afloat.
7. Do respect the privacy of your neighbors. Also remember, sound carries very well across the lakes.
8. Do be especially careful about open fires on your property, particularly in dry weather. A fire permit is necessary.
9. Do not trespass on the property of others, in summer or winter. Snowmobiles particularly, damage both terrain, small shrubs and trees.
10. Please take good care of our disposal sight and observe dumping rules.
11. Drive carefully on our roads - do not exceed 15 M.P.H. and watch for children, motor bikes, and bicycles.
12. Do enjoy yourself, but not at the expense of others. This area is everyone's investment.
