We are very pleased to announce the initial formation of the Three Lakes Development Association and sincerely hope that our unity and combined efforts will improve the surrounding environment in this community.

The purpose of this organization is to work together as a team and pool our ideas for the betterment and future progress of this entire area.

At the present time this area serves the needs of over 150 residents. This means we must insist on better roads, posted speed limits, controlled garbage disposal and join together to fight pollution and ever increasing taxes.

The one way to accomplish the above goals is to form a strong group of volunteers who are willing to work and meet with government officials in an effort to make this a better place to live and play.

Our #1 project is already under way and, as many of you already know or have heard, our garbage disposal sight has been completely revamped and posted. We will be able to continue dumping refuse for at least another two seasons without the Health Department closing us down. As most of us know, our dump was a sorry mess and very detrimental towards the integrity of our entire population.

As of this date we have personally contacted over 75 families and proceeded to collect funds to help support and pay for these much needed improvements. The suggested rate for summer residents is \$3.00 for the balance of 1971 and \$5.00 for those families living year round.


Re: Three Lakes Development Association


Enclosed you will find a list of do's and don't's; please read and pass on to the other members of your family.
