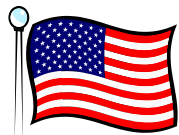
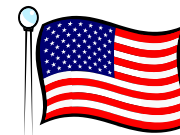

TLDA Fall Meeting Minutes  
August 24, 2019

**Roll Call:** Elizabeth called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. She welcomed everyone in attendance. Ron and Maureen have sold their cabin; therefore, Ron is no longer on the board. As Vice President, Elizabeth will become the President, until the new election next fall.

Elizabeth called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m.

Motion by Bill Kubiak, seconded by Dave Fulda, to accept the March 2, 2019, Board Meeting minutes, motion approved.

### **Financial Report:**

TLDA Balance	\$5,441.37 (\$200.00 picnic expense remaining to be paid)
Water Quality Balance	\$2,142.78 (\$255.00 water quality testing expense remaining to be paid).

### **New Business:**

- Ron was president of the TLDA for many years and loved it up here; he spent a lot of his own time and money on many projects. We are taking up a collection in recognition and appreciation for all of his contributions. We are also looking for ideas for a gift for

him. If you have any ideas, please send them our way. Motion by Jim Schafhauser, seconded by Bill Kubiak to spend \$150.00 on a gift for Ron from the TLDA, motion passed.

- Peter Jongewaard had printouts from the DNR web page “Lake Finder” of the five lakes (Dodo, Elora, Rose, Strand, and Winkle) showing data collected between 1995 and 2019. There are no major changes in water quality and clarity. Since 2010, we have been collecting one sample per lake per year.
- AED – There is no longer an AED on Rose Lake; it is currently located at Bill Lowry’s home on Lake Elora. It was suggested that the address and phone number be published on the location of the AED. The French Club also has an AED outside of their back door. The heartbeat flashes at night, and when the AED is opened, a piercing alarm will go off and people will respond.
- We will have a speaker from the MN DNR talking about water safety and shoreline erosion at our next meeting. As a safety concern, boats should not be going between rafts and docks.
- Items for consideration – 3 Lakes website and/or 3 Lakes neighborhood app.
- Please remind your guests to slow down when driving on roads around the lakes; many people are out walking.
- MN Lakes and Rivers Association- There are 194 lake associations in the state that belong to this association; we currently do not belong. Dues are \$150.00 per year for 51-150 members and \$200.00 per year for 151-300 members. The association will host

our own 3 Lakes web page for an additional fee of \$100.00 per year. Motion by Elizabeth to join the MN Lakes and Rivers Assn at a cost of \$250.00 per year, seconded by Dave Fulda, motion approved.

- The burning of the brush pile is scheduled for the Friday after Thanksgiving, November 29, at 9:00 a.m. Reminder - the brush pile is for brush only. Many thanks to Dan Hartel and Kurt Gronseth, who continue to monitor the pile year long.
- Thanks to everyone who attended the TLDA/FC picnic. There were a lot of TLDA attendees.
- A pair of black glasses and keys with a fob were found recently and placed on the bench by the Parenteau residence.
- A current listing of TLDA members has not been published lately. There was some discussion what the listing should include; i.e., names, addresses, phone numbers, e-mail addresses, etc. When we send out the next dues statement, we will include a statement authorizing us to publish this information to members of the TLDA.
- Attendance was down at the Fourth of July parade this year. Perhaps we could send out a reminder e-mail six weeks in advance.

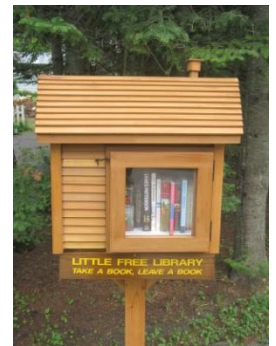
### **Around the Lakes**
