New Business:

- Water Testing – Peter stated all lakes will be tested again this year for phosphorus and chlorophyll, as has been done for the last 25 years, starting in 1995. One sample from each of the five lakes will be collected the weekend of July 15th. Official reports are posted on the MN DNR Lake Finder web site.
- French Club Bingo – will be held on Saturday, July 9, at 7:00 pm.
- There will be no TLDA sponsored garage sale.
- Highway 49 Road Construction – Dan Zezulka and Jerry VanGuilder, with St. Louis County Public Works Department, gave an update on road construction on both sides of the road from the French Club to Winkle Lane through 2025. They are not responsible for the design of the road, only in charge of the maintenance. Construction will affect 25 feet from the centerline on both sides of the road. Work on ditches will start in 2024, and major road work will begin in 2025. They will be more aggressive on the side of the road that does not have property. Grating on the road by Rose Lake is the responsibility of the township. Highway 49 will be one lane passable out to Highway 4. Repaving will include replacement of culverts.
