This letter will serve as authorization for the Three Lakes Development Association to have a brush/yard waste disposal area on State Tax Forfeited lands in the designated area described. The disposal area is subject to the limitations and restrictions listed below.

Legal Description: NE¼ of the SW¼ of Section 31, T54N, R16W

The authorized disposal area lies east of South Strand Lake Road as depicted on the map.

Payment Amount: \$200

This letter must be available on-site when working on State tax-forfeited lands.

Limitations and Restrictions:

1. Only vegetative material such as tree branches, brush, grass clippings, and leaves may be disposed of at this site.
2. The Three Lakes Development Association is responsible for removal/burning of all material dumped at this site. The Land Department may require removal/burning by a specified date if the quantity of material is getting too large as determined by the Land Department. The Three Lakes Development Association is responsible for obtaining a burning permit prior to any burning of material.
3. Only minor excavation required to level the area is authorized. No removal of sand or burying of material is authorized and would need prior approval from the Area Manager of the St. Louis County Land Department.
4. Debris will not be placed or pushed into the forest beyond the designated brush piling area.
5. The County reserves the right to use this disposal area for forest management access purposes.
6. Permittee agrees to indemnify, save, and hold harmless the County of St. Louis, its agents and employees, from any and all claims, demands, actions or causes of action of whatsoever nature or character arising out of or by reason of the execution or performance of the terms and conditions provided for in this permit and further agrees to defend at its own sole cost and expense, any actions or proceedings commenced for the purpose of asserting any claim of whatsoever character arising hereunder.




