AED Update – Strand Lake: Greg Larson spoke to Scott Carlson and they're willing to build an outdoor heated structure for the AED. Greg has the AED now. TLDA will donate towards the structure and Strand Lake association will donate the balance of the funds.

Brush Pile Update: It's being watched! There is ongoing dumping of things that shouldn't be in there. The county is keeping an eye on the dump and the logging around the dump area.

Road Work Update –Bill Lowry called and will have an update by the next board meeting.

Lake Updates: Dodo- Outlet clogged (beaver issues), Peter Jongewaard notified the county and they came and cleaned it out right away. **Lake Elora-** water level is up.

Rose Lake-water level is down and one place for sale. **Strand Lake**- one place for sale. No other updates at this time.

Road Clean-up Fall – Set Date: Went well. Fall road clean up date is October 3, 2026 at 8:00 am.
